SIMS Parent Lite App

You should now have received an email inviting you to join the SIMS Parent Lite App. This system allows you to update contact information for you and your child whilst keeping in line with the new General Data Protection Regulations. It would be incredibly beneficial to the school if you could use this system to ensure we have up to date contact details in case of emergency.

We can only issue activation codes to parents who have parental responsibility for a child and who live at the same address. If you have not received an activation code or you would like to know more information, please call in to the school office. Thank you.

Scooter Safety

Please can we remind all parents/carers of children who come to school independently that care must be taken when arriving and leaving school. We have been advised that some children are riding scooters to school without care and in some cases in the middle of the road. If your child does come to school without adult supervision, please ensure you speak with them about staying safe on the journey to and from school. Can we also remind you not to allow your children to ride scooters and bikes on the playground.

A parent has also advised that they have lost a red scooter, this went missing earlier this week from the scooter stand. If you have any information regarding this, please let the office know. Thank you.
