With the support and assistance of some key partners, North Yorkshire Police have been delivering Crucial Crew safety workshops to Year 6 pupils across the region for over twenty years. Since the very first session approximately 200,000 children have taken part in the fun, interactive sessions and learnt some vital, life-saving skills to take forward into their adult life.

The workshop sessions cover vital personal safety and behaviour topics such as road safety, internet safety, water safety and how to make an emergency call, and much, much more.
