We will learn about the sinking of the Titanic by studying factual accounts and will use this information to write a chronological report. We will also develop our writing skills through writing short narrative and Calligram poems.

In Maths, we will continue to develop our fluency, reasoning and problem solving skills through a range of concepts including temperature data on line graphs.

In Science, we will develop our knowledge and understanding of living things, in particular classification and feeding relationships. We will investigate thermal insulators and conductors.

We will take inspiration from the artwork of the Inuit, creating printed designs. We will work with paint to create pictures of the Northern Lights.
