"Sound of Music" concert

In November a number of children joined children from other schools in Northallerton to perform a "Sound of Music" concert. We have now been given the details of the amount raised and wanted to share that with everyone.

The overall proceeds from the Concert at the Forum raised £4100. This sum has been forwarded to Nepal into the keeping of the ROTARY CLUB of the HIMALAYAN GURKHAS towards the repair and rebuilding of a water tank and the accompanying pipework to the Shree Pancharum Village, which had been destroyed in the earthquakes. This means that 95 people will have fresh water piped straight to their homes and young people will not have to walk long distances before school to carry water back to their families.

Additionally the efforts of the schools involved have funded a small Goat Farm. This will enable another community in a nearby village to be self-sufficient in goat meat, milk, cheese, fertiliser and pelts for winter warmth.

The Rotarians involved certainly concluded that Northallerton could be justifiably proud of its primary schools!

On Monday 12th June, a sporting event at Broomfield took place. 10 people from each year group took part in a 50 metre sprint, a 400 metre long distance run, a ball throw and a long jump. We competed against all of the other Northallerton schools. We had a good time because it was great fun and it was very athletic.
