Outright Campaign 2017

On Monday 20th November we celebrated World Children's Day and supported UNICEF's Outright Campaign which focused upon raising awareness of the rights of refugee children.

Throughout school we spent time learning about why children are forced to become refugees and how this puts their safety at risk. We were very impressed with how sensible and empathetic the children were.

The decision to fundraise to support refugee children was decided by our Rights Respecting Ambassadors. Keeva-Leigh (Y5) and Lenisha (Y3) wrote:

We all had great fun completing the 'Scramble' which was a very muddy obstacle course. We chose to do this as it represented obstacles. Refugee children have to face many, more serious obstacles to escape from their country which is at war. Some children have to leave their families and homes and some even die doing this.
