FoRS Fundraising

We wanted to say a huge thank you to everyone who has contributed and supported FoRS events so far this year. We have already raised just over £4000 since September with many more exciting events to come.

The intention of FoRS is to raise funds to go towards supporting activities and resources in school. With money raised last year and our current fundraising it is wonderful to say that we are in the process of spending £10,000 within the school. This incredible amount will provide:

- A purpose built shed to store and protect all the new sports equipment.
- Replacement sails for the outdoor KS1 area.
- The purchase and replacement of new Chromebooks.
- The purchase of new sets of KS1 phonic books and group reader books in KS2 to replace and update previous ones.
- An additional amount towards the already provided £2500 for bus costs for school trips to help with the ever-rising cost of transport and help to keep school trip costs lower.
