## **Local Authority SEN Survey**

The Local Authority have asked all schools to share the survey below with parents. They are aiming to get a broad consensus on the essential elements and format for a SEND Inclusive Practice Framework. The Framework will aim to guide teachers and school staff in reviewing inclusive practice in their school, to ensure schools can create learning environments that are inclusive to all children and to give a common set of expectations about what a school could be doing to meet the needs of children aged 5-16 with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.
