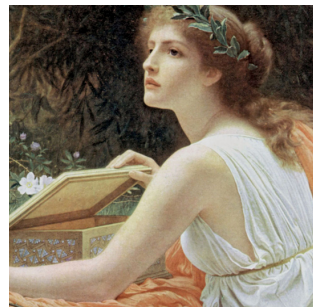


Y1/2 Curriculum letter

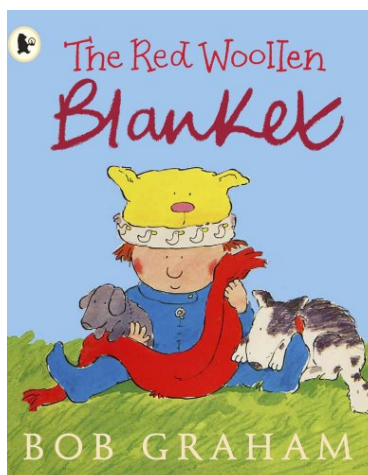


ENGLISH

Our English work this half term will start with an exploration of the lovely story book 'The Red Woollen Blanket' by Bob Graham. We will also read the story of Pandora's Box and write poetry based on the Kit Wright poem 'The Magic Box'.

MATHS

Our Maths learning will begin with work on weighing and measuring. Later in the half term we will look at fractions and of course, continue to revisit what we know about the number system and +, -, x and ÷.



HISTORY

Lots of History involved in this project. It's all about exploring memories and thinking about the past. What can you remember or find out about your story from when you were born? What can we find out about times before you were born? How have things like transport and household items changed since Mum or Dad were small, or Grandma and Grandad's childhood?

SCIENCE
