We will find out about nocturnal animals and how they find food when it is dark.

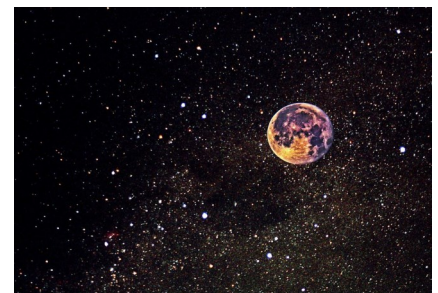


We will learn about people who work at night and different jobs that people do when we are asleep. We will discuss our bedtime routines such as cleaning teeth and the importance of a good nights sleep.
